<p>Project Description: The principal activity of the proposed project is the clearing of approximately 140 m by 12.2 m of land for the purpose of installing a two pole power line. The proposed power line is to be constructed from km 1255 on the Alaska Highway to Lot 1052. The project is located approximately 15 kilometers from the Village of Teslin and is anticipated to take place in late fall of 2008 or early spring of 2009.</p> <p>Project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - clearing of land; - installation of two power poles and one anchor; - use of heavy equipment; - disposal of cleared debris; and - reclamation.

All heavy equipment shall be well maintained and kept in good working order. 3. Timber cleared from the power line right-of-way that is over 10 cm in diameter shall be salvaged for firewood and made available to the public. <p>Yukon Government modifies the following condition:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. During brushing and maintenance of the power line right-of-way, the proponent shall ensure that stumps and stubs are kept low to the ground and mulched. <p>Replaced with:</p> <p>During brushing and maintenance of the power line right-of-way, the proponent shall ensure that tree stumps and deciduous stems are cut flush or as close to the ground as possible.</p> <p>Justification:</p> <p>Preferred wording. Branches and small items will be mulched, but stumps will not.</p>
