Project Description: The proposed project consists of the construction, installation and operation of a power line to service Lot 1122 off Squatter's Road. The new power line will start from the existing Yukon Electrical Company Limited Land License (#2005-0056). Clearing and brushing of vegetation over a width of 12.2m and for a length of approximately 100m on Crown land, crossing the access road to Lot 1158 is required to facilitate power line installation. Construction of this new power line is anticipated to take place over two weeks during fall of 2011 or early spring of 2012 and will occur in conjunction with power line construction already approved within Land License 2005-0056.		
Project activities include:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clearing and brushing on Crown Land and Lot #1122; • Installation of one new power pole and anchor on Crown land; • Disposal of any cleared debris and salvage of any cut trees; and • On-going maintenance of the power line.
