<b>Project Description:</b> The proposed project consists of the construction, installation and operation of a power line. The new power line will start from the Alaska Highway and extend to Lot 1309 Quad 105D/14, which is located approximately 30 km northwest of Whitehorse and accessed via the Alaska Highway. Clearing and brushing of vegetation is proposed over a width of 12.1 m and for a length of approximately 2 km on Crown land to facilitate the power line installation. Clearing and brushing is anticipated to start at the end of July 2011 and may take 2-3 weeks to complete. Construction of the power line is anticipated to commence shortly after brushing and will take 1-2 weeks to complete.		
Project activities include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• stringing 2 km single phase power line;</li> <li>• brushing right-of-way;</li> <li>• installation of a total of 25 new poles;</li> <li>• installation of a total of 8 anchors;</li> <li>• use of digger truck and backhoe;</li> <li>• disposal of cleared debris and salvage of any cut trees; and</li> <li>• on-going maintenance of the power line.</li> </ul>
