| <p>Project Description:</p> <p>The proposed project consists of clearing land for the installation of a repeater tower/pole, power line and access route. The new tower will be located near Mt. Berdoe, adjacent to Lot 132, Group 903. There is existing access to the proposed site from Carmacks (approximately 12 km). The project is to occur on Crown land and is anticipated to commence in July 2011 and will require approximately 2 weeks to complete.</p> <p>Principal activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • clearing land for tower/pole installation, new power line corridor and access route (approx. 12 m wide x up to a maximum of 148 m long); and • tower/pole installation. <p>Accessory activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • construction and installation of container unit (approx. 8' x 8'); • connection to existing power line; and • operation and maintenance of repeater site as required. | |
