Project Description: The proposed project involves clearing of land and earthworks for the purpose of installing a power line off Mountainview Drive near Hickory Street in the Porter Creek Subdivision in the City of Whitehorse. The purpose of the project is to connect the Whistle Bend Substation with the electrical grid. Power line installation will overlap with the proponent's existing License of Occupation as well as Crown land. The proponent is applying to Yukon Government for a Land Use permit for work occurring outside of the existing right-of-way. Construction of the power line is anticipated to commence in the summer of 2011 and will take approximately five days to complete.	
Project activities include:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Installation of approximately 50 m of power line in total within existing right-of-way and Crown land, including overhead and underground portions; • Clearing and brushing of a 13.18 m wide by 12.7 m wide power line right-of-way on Crown land; • Trenching for installation of 13 m of underground power line; • Installation of 2 poles and 2 anchors; • Disposal of cleared debris; and • On-going maintenance of the power line.
