<p>Project Description: The proposed project is the construction, installation and long-term maintenance and operation of a 590 meter distribution line, including 7 power poles, to provide power to a residence on Lot 1111, Plan 97045 CSLR. The project is located approximately 4.5 km from the Village of Mayo along the Silver Trail Highway at the Wareham Lake Dam Access Road. The distribution line will run from an existing distribution line west of the property, across the access road, and connect to Lot 1111. Construction of the power line is anticipated to commence September 2011 will take two weeks to complete.</p> <p>Project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clearing and brushing on Crown land (approximately 3,350m²) • Earthworks associated with installation of power poles • Disposal of brush and trees • On-going maintenance of power line
