Proponent Name:	Yukon Electrical Company Limited
Project Description: The proposed project involves clearing of land and earthworks for the purpose of installing a power line to the NorthWestTel Fox Point Microwave Tower site. The purpose of the project is to provide single phase power to the site by connecting it with the electrical grid. The proponent is applying to Yukon government for a Land Use Permit for work occurring outside of the existing right-of-way. Construction of the power line is anticipated to start in the fall of 2011 and will take approximately 5 weeks to complete.	
Project Activities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Installation of approximately 3,253 m of power line within the existing right-of-way, on Commissioner's Land and on private property; • Installation of 44 poles, 30 anchors and related infrastructure; • Clearing and brushing (3,253 m in length by 12.2 m in width); • Use of heavy equipment; • Site clean-up, including disposal of cleared debris; and • Ongoing maintenance of the power line and right-of-way.
