Project Description: The proposed project consists of a geotechnical investigation to support quarry development within a 150 hectare parcel of land located approximately 2.7 km south of McLean Lake Road. This is approximately 14 km southwest of downtown Whitehorse within the municipal boundaries. Access to the project area is by McLean Lake Road and the Copper Haul Road. No clearing is anticipated, as heavily forested areas will be avoided. The activities are proposed to occur over a three to four day period between May and October 2011.	
Principal activities include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • excavating test pits to delineate resources (approx. 20); • use of heavy equipment; • waste management; • fuel use (truck-mounted Tidy Tank); and • reclamation.
