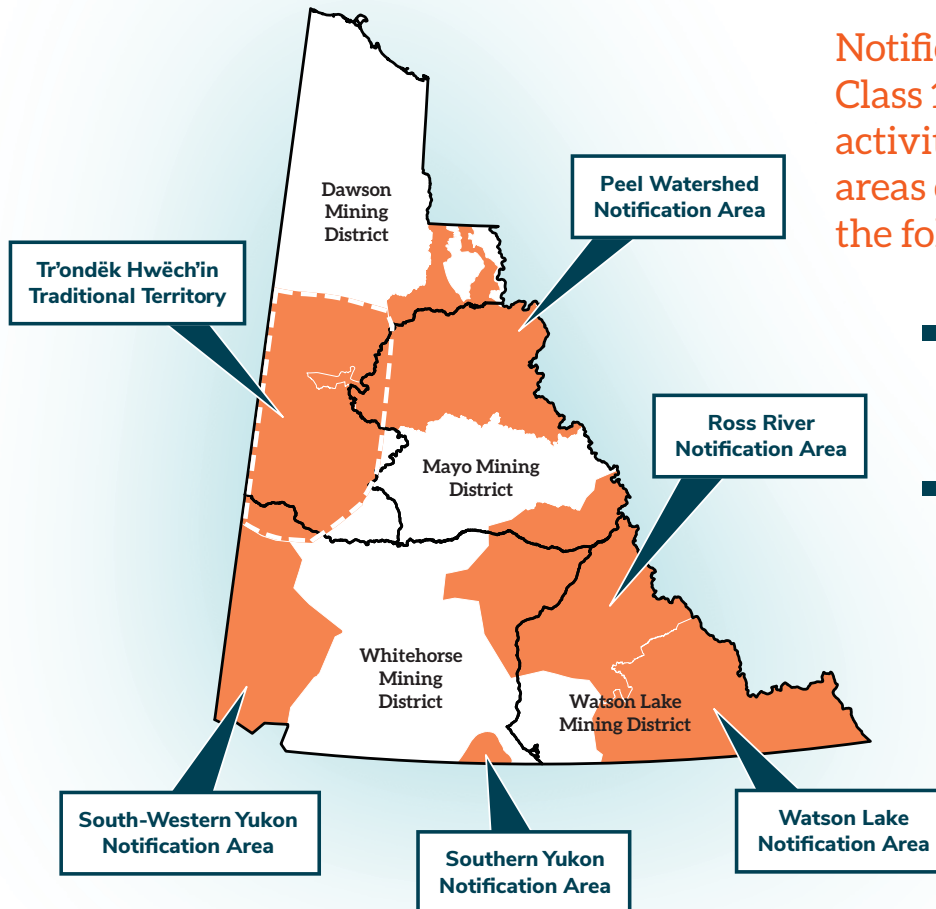


# CLASS 1 NOTIFICATION



Notification is required for Class 1 mineral exploration activities in the highlighted areas on the map and in the following areas:

- Categories A and B First Nation Settlement Land;
- On April 1, 2018, Traditional Territory of Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in

## NOTIFICATION PROCESS

- 1** Notification must be submitted to the Mining Recorders office or online using the Class 1 Notification System a minimum of 25 days before starting Class 1 activities. Submit the notification as early as possible to provide adequate time for consultation and possible extensions.
- 2** Once the notification is complete, the Mining Recorders office initiates consultation with the affected First Nation inviting comments on adverse effects to Aboriginal or Treaty rights.
- 3** The Chief, Mining Land Use will review comments and make one of the following determinations within 25 days.
  - ➔ Allow the program to proceed as proposed;
  - ➔ Grant an extension of the review period;
  - ➔ Amend the Class 1 Notification to allow it to proceed, after seeking the operator's views; or
  - ➔ Refuse the program as proposed, by giving written notice to the operator and the affected First Nations.
- 4** Class 1 Notification basic information and terms and conditions are posted publicly on the Government of Yukon website.

The Government of Yukon will launch a new online notification system in April 2018.
