

Recommended Steps for Mining Land Use Projects



When developing a Mining Land Use program it is recommended to follow these steps before submitting your project to YESAB to help mitigate any potential land use conflicts:

- ❑ Using the [Placer](#) or [Quartz](#) threshold table, determine which class of Mining Land Use your project falls within.
- ❑ Contact each affected Yukon First Nation, and/or transboundary First Nation in your project area:
